

SECTION AT GABLE RAKE

(FILE NAME: 4-2.DWG)

The ridges and hips are built with the same 18" tile that is used for the field of the roof and each tile is nailed with one non-corrosive nail to the wood nailing strips.

The double eave tile is used on nearly all residential work as it enhances the appearance by giving an added thickness of tile along the edge. However, it can be omitted if desired as is sometimes done on commercial or formal buildings. If the double eave is not used, then it is necessary to nail a 1"x16" clay cant strip along the lower edge of the sheathing to give the necessary tilt to the starting pan tile. its use is optional when double eave tiles are used.
