

Gladding, McBean's Cotswold Shingle Tile has a wire-cut face with scalloped edges. The length of the tile is 14" with 4 widths at 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ ", 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 9" wide. Tile is generally laid with a 8" exposure. Tile may also be laid with a random exposure.

10" Exposure: 185-pcs/Sq. Wt. 907 lbs./Sq.
8" Exposure: 231-pcs/Sq. Wt. 1132 lbs./Sq.
6" Exposure: 308-pcs/Sq. Wt. 1510 lbs./Sq.
